1. Rational

On the Auspicious Occasion of "the Seventieth Anniversary Celebrations of His Majesty's Accession to the Throne" and "the Celebrations on the Auspicious Occasion of Her Majesty the Queen's 7th Cycle Birthday Anniversary 12th August 2016", the Office of the Permanent Secretary, the Prime Minister's Office shall organize the ASEAN Youth Representatives Experiencing the Philosophy of Sufficiency Economy (AY-REPSE 2016, Thailand), which is aimed at celebrating on such auspicious events and disseminating the royal grace of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej and Her Majesty Queen Sirikit, dedicated both time and efforts to the development work for the betterment of Thai people, to the ASEAN youth representatives for further sustainable development in their own countries.

The program also provides a benefit venue for the understanding of the Philosophy of Sufficiency Economy which is raised by the United Nations (UN) as being beneficial to the United States of America and other countries, and also encouraged member states to adhere to the guidelines for sustainable development. The Philosophy of Sufficiency Economy has occurred from the royal speeches and become the mould for the Philosophy representing the guiding light to help the Thai people and society to survive through the hard times of the 1997 economic crisis.

This program shall provide the youths from each country of ASEAN with the precious opportunity to learn, practice and experience mainly focusing on the Philosophy of Sufficiency Economy through theory, site visit of the royal initiatives in regions, and participation in the related activities. Besides, it is also a good opportunity to launch a connectivity network of ASEAN youths in realizing the aims of ASEAN community "One Vision, One Identity, One Community".

2. Project Objectives

1. To disseminate the royal grace of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej and Her Majesty Queen Sirikit On the Auspicious Occasion of "the Seventieth Anniversary Celebrations of His Majesty's Accession to the Throne" and "the Celebrations on the Auspicious Occasion of Her Majesty the Queen's 7th Cycle Birthday Anniversary 12th August 2016".
2. To enhance and strengthen mutual understanding on the Royal Initiatives of His Majesty the King and Her Majesty the Queen to ASEAN youth representatives.
3. To promote learning and applying the Royal Initiatives as the life guidance for all levels and further leading to the integrated sustainable development in each ASEAN country.
4. To drive and launch a connectivity network of ASEAN youth in realizing the aims of ASEAN community and foster a close relationship and understanding among the youth of ASEAN countries.

3. Main Program

The program has been created to disseminate the Royal Initiatives of His Majesty the King and Her Majesty the Queen in promoting the learning and mutual understanding of the Philosophy of Sufficiency Economy among the ASEAN youths; to educate and practice them on how the Sufficiency Economy leads to a sustainable form of development in all aspects. The program comprises of the following activities:

- 2) Site visit

 - The Golden Jubilee Museum of Agriculture Office
 - Hui Hong Khrai Royal Development Study Centre, Chaing Mai province
 - Puparn Royal Development Study Centre, Sakon Nakhon province
 - Kung Krabaen Bay Royal Development Study Centre, Chanthaburi province
- 3) Learning-by-doing activities
- 4) Community service activities
- 5) Lesson Learned
- 6) Cultural performance for the closing ceremony (your own country/collaborative output)
- 7) Advanced assignment – country report; all participants are requested to prepare a 10-minute country report

5. Official Languages

English language shall be the communication language for this program.

6. Participants

The program expects to welcome 70 ASEAN youth representatives from 10 ASEAN countries from Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Singapore, Vietnam, and Thailand. Each ASEAN country shall be represented by only 7 youths which shall be qualified and nominated by the Embassy of each ASEAN country in Thailand.

7. Participant Qualifications

The Office of the Permanent Secretary, the Prime Minister's Office shall assign the fundamental qualifications of the ASEAN youths participating the program. The additional qualifications depend on the discretion of the Embassy of each ASEAN country.

- 1) Have an education background / be interested in His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej of the Kingdom of Thailand Initiatives and/or Royal Projects in Thailand
- 2) Be a citizen and resident of ASEAN Member States
- 3) Must be at least 18 years old and no more than 25 years old
- 4) Hold a valid passport with a minimum validity of 6 months on the travelling date
- 5) Be creative, and possess the potential leadership skill
- 6) Have an experience in related activities or projects (if any)
- 7) Possess functional level of written and spoken English
- 8) Be able to actively participate in discussions, and deliver presentations in English
- 9) Be in good health to be able to attend the whole program and well-prepared for camping

8. Expenditure / Funding

The Office of the Permanent Secretary, the Prime Minister's Office, as the host, shall bear the following costs during the program which include

1. The international travel cost (airfare ticket) and domestic travel cost (within Thailand)
2. Hotel accommodation cost during participation in the program
3. Inland transportation for all official visits in the program
4. Food expenses (meals)
5. Activity expenses

The participants are responsible for their own domestic travelling expenses in their countries and other expenses in addition shall be borne by the participants.

9. Travel Insurance

The participants from the ASEAN countries are responsible for making a travel insurance before travelling to Thailand. Due to arriving Thailand, the Office of the Permanent Secretary, the Prime Minister's Office shall bear the cost of accidental insurance during participation in this program in Thailand.
